


Dear Participant,

Race Pack Collection

- Distribution at the Schauinsland-Reisen-Arena during the Marathon Expo on Saturday, May 17, 2025 (10:00 AM – 7:00 PM) and Sunday, May 18, 2025 (from 6:00 AM until the start)
- For good medical care, write the contact details on the back of the race bib
- The race bib will indicate the pre-ordered shirt size
- For personal support, pre-registered participants will have their name on the race bib
- Late registrants should write their name with a thick marker

Before the Start

- Attach the race bib to the front of your shirt
- Attach the chip to your shoe
- Carry the sponge
- Toilets are available at the start area and on Kruppstraße

Changing Rooms

- Sorted by starting groups
- Includes toilets

Bag Drop

- Containers from Fa. Kons & Pusnik at the Action Area on Bertaallee
- (SK) Inline skaters deposit their belongings at the ice sports hall
- Do not leave bags unattended

Ready, Steady, GO!

- Follow the green marking for the optimal running route
- Every kilometer is marked
- Clocks are placed every 5 kilometers
- Control points with referees from the North Rhine Athletics Association Region North are along the course
- Pace setters for the Marathon: 3:00 hrs/3:15 hrs/3:30 hrs/3:45 hrs/4:00 hrs/4:15 hrs/4:30 hrs/4:45 hrs/5:00 hrs/5:30 hrs
- Pace setters for the Half Marathon: 1:30 hrs/1:45 hrs/2:00 hrs/2:15 hrs/2:30 hrs/2:45 hrs

Prohibited on the Course

- Bike accompaniment will lead to disqualification
- Slowing down/stopping in the middle of the road
- Running hand-in-hand, especially in the finish area
- Be considerate of other runners; only in doing so will it be a great and unforgettable event for everyone.

Personal Nutrition

- Submission until May 17, 2025, 7:00 PM at the race bib collection point
- No glass containers allowed
- (SK) Not possible for inline skaters

Time Limit

- Marathon 5:30 hours
- Half Marathon 2:45 hours
- Inline Skaters 2:30 hours

Medical Care

- Proceed to the nearest aid station
- Mobile first aid responders will be called from there
- Recovery buses will circulate during the marathon to transport athletes to the medical services at the Schauinsland-Reisen-Arena

We ask that the winning runners report to the award podium 15 minutes before the ceremony. First-place runners will receive a note at the finish line.

Additional Information for Participants of the Rhein-Ruhr-Relay-Half Marathon

Dear Relay Participants,

We are excited that you have decided to participate in the Rhein-Ruhr Relay Half Marathon in Duisburg 2025! To ensure that you can enjoy the competition without worries, we have compiled all the important information for you.

Timing

Each relay team requires a baton. The baton will be distributed at the start number pickup in the Schauinsland-Reisen-Arena. Please return the baton undamaged at the appropriate return station when leaving the stadium grounds. If the rented baton is not returned, your account will be charged €16.00.

Finish Line

You are welcome to gather in front of the finish line in the Schauinsland-Reisen-Arena to cross the finish line together as a team. Please note that it is not possible to meet the final runner at the finish line.

Legs of the Race and Runner Information

The relay half marathon will start at 10:00 AM.

1st Leg:

From the start to the first relay exchange point in Duisburg city center, Steinsche Gasse at BSG Stadtwerke (KM 5).

Please remember to bring the baton.

• 2nd Leg:

From the first exchange point to the second exchange point, Wanheimerort, Düsseldorfer Str. 590, at VS 12 of Duisburg Sport Club 1900 (KM 10). The second runner should arrive at the first exchange point by 10:15 AM to take over the baton.

• 3rd Leg:

From the second exchange point to the third exchange point, Großenbaum, Großenbaumer Allee 168, SPD Ortsverein Duisburg Großenbaum, Gesamtschule Süd (KM 16).

The third runner should arrive by 10:30 AM at the third exchange point to take over the baton.

4th Leg:

From the third exchange point to the finish line at the Schauinsland-Reisen-Arena. You can gather here before the finish line and run into the arena together.

Exchange Points

The relay exchange points are clearly marked along the race route. At each exchange point, there is a designated "pit lane" with different exchange zones sorted by start numbers.

Getting to the Relay Exchange Points

- Relay Exchange Point 1 (Duisburg City Center, Steinsche Gasse):
 You can reach this exchange point by shuttle bus, which will depart from the
 Schauinsland-Reisen-Arena every 10-15 minutes starting at 09:00 AM. Look for the
 bus signs. Alternatively, you can use public transportation:
 o Subway/Tram station Steinsche Gasse (U79, 903).
- Relay Exchange Point 2 (Wanheimerort, Düsseldorfer Straße):
 The shuttle bus also runs from the Schauinsland-Reisen-Arena from 09:00 AM, every 10-15 minutes. Alternatively, you can use the Waldfriedhof subway station (U79).
- Relay Exchange Point 3 (Großenbaum, Großenbaumer Allee):
 The shuttle bus will depart every 10-15 minutes from 09:00 AM from the Schauinsland-Reisen-Arena.

Additional information for participants in the Inline Skating marathon

Dear participants,

We have compiled additional information for you so that you can enjoy the competition without any worries:

Eligibility and classification groups

Juniors, active athletes, Masters U40, Masters U50, Masters U60, Masters U70, Masters U80 and Masters U80 who are in possession of a valid DRIV license. Please note the special regulations for high starts.

Start numbers

The start number must be worn by all participants* on the right thigh in a clearly recognizable manner as instructed. Without a start number, or with a poorly recognizable start number, you will be rejected and will not be scored for this run. Any bending or folding of the start number will automatically lead to disqualification!

In addition, the two timing transponder strips (MikaTags) must be stuck to the helmet (instructions with the start number), as otherwise no complete time recording can take place.

Starting blocks

There will be no separate starting blocks. The start for all participants is at 08:00. The organizers will ensure that the elite riders are positioned at the front of the starting field.

Roll size

The following specification for the maximum wheel size applies to all participants: 125mm

The WKO of the DRIV in conjunction with the WKO of the FIRS, in particular with regard to wheel size, must be observed. Competitors with larger wheels will be removed from the classification or disqualified.

Finish line

The finish line for the Rhein Ruhr Inline Marathon with classification is located in the stadium.

The scoring for the WSC Cup will take place separately (to be determined by the organizing team of the WSC Cup). Subject to change!
